Seniors

1. **GLOBE**, which sponsors the Texas Scholar Program has a new mission and that mission is to collaborate with business and education to improve the regional workforce by helping parents and students understand the maximum value of the K through 12 experience. The change that affects seniors this year is there will be no GLOBE ceremony, but there will be a career expo held on either February 28th or March 1st.
